

# Australia Post Travel Platinum Card - Bonus Campaign

## Australia Post Travel Platinum Card – Promotion Terms & Conditions of Entry (“Conditions of Entry”)

1. The promoter is Australian Postal Corporation ABN 28 864 970 579, AR No 338646 of 480 Swan St., Richmond, VIC 3121 (the “**Promoter**”). Mastercard Prepaid Management Services Australia Pty Ltd ABN 47 145 452 044, AFSL 386 837 (“**Mastercard Prepaid**”) arranges for the issue of the Australia Post Travel Platinum Mastercard® facility (“**Travel Platinum Card**”) and Travel Platinum Card in conjunction with the issuer, EML Payment Solutions Limited (“**EML**”) ABN 30 131 436 532, AFSL 404131.
2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia who are new Travel Platinum Card cardholders in Australia and loads in foreign currency (other than AU Dollars) with a minimum amount of \$100 (Australian Dollar equivalent), between 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026 9:00 ADST and 31<sup>st</sup> May 2026 23:59 ADST inclusive (“**Promotion Period**”) in a single transaction instore or online at [auspost.com.au/travelcard](https://auspost.com.au/travelcard) and successfully registers their transaction online at [auspost.com.au/register](https://auspost.com.au/register) (“**Eligible Entrant**”).
3. The bonus amount available under this promotion varies depending on the value of the qualifying foreign currency load made on an eligible Travel Platinum Card during the Promotional Period. Subject to these Terms and Conditions, eligible customers who satisfy all promotional requirements may receive one of the following bonus amounts:
  - A\$10 bonus where a qualifying foreign currency load of A\$100 (or equivalent) is made;
  - A\$30 bonus where a qualifying foreign currency load of A\$800 (or equivalent) is made; or
  - A\$40 bonus where a qualifying foreign currency load of A\$1,000 (or equivalent) is made.

The applicable bonus amount will be determined solely by the value of the qualifying load made. Only one bonus may be awarded per eligible customer, and bonuses are subject to availability and any applicable promotional caps. The promotional caps is A\$32,000.
4. The bonus is limited to the first 800 Eligible Entrants who successfully load, register using the designated link above during the Promotional Period, and are selected based on a game of skill, as assessed against the criteria set out in these terms and conditions. Eligible entries will be judged based on pre-determined criteria, including originality and creativity. Chance plays no part in determining the selected Eligible Entrants. 7. Eligible Entrants must not be in breach of any terms and conditions of this promotion or of the terms and conditions of their relevant Travel Platinum Card.

The Promoter reserves the right to review and amend these terms and conditions, with prior notice provided where reasonable. Decision of the Promoter is final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

8. The promotion will be advertised online at [auspost.com.au/travelcard](https://auspost.com.au/travelcard). Any enquiries regarding the promotion should in the first instance be directed to the Promoter.
9. The successful Eligible Entrants who will receive a bonus will be determined on 8 June 2026 at 12:00pm (AEST), in accordance with the selection method set out in these terms and conditions. Entries submitted by the Eligible Entrants become the property of the Promoter. 10. Eligible Entrants will be credited with the bonus amount to their Australian Dollar currency wallet on their relevant Travel Platinum Card ("**Bonus**"). All amounts will be credited to Bonus recipients by 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
11. The Promoter may, in its sole discretion, cancel or vary the promotion at any time. If the Promoter cancels or varies the promotion, it is not liable to any person for any costs, loss or damage whatsoever arising out of, or in connection with, such cancellation or variation and is not required to conduct the promotion at any other time.
12. The Bonus must be taken as stated. If an Eligible Entrant is unable to use the Bonus as stated it will be forfeited and no compensation will be payable.
13. Eligible Entrants may be liable to declare the Bonus for tax purposes. The Promoter takes no responsibility for any tax payable on the Bonus. If any tax is payable on the Bonus it is the sole responsibility of the Eligible Entrant.
14. If the Bonus is not available for reasons beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute for something of similar theme and value and this will be at the Promoter's sole discretion.
15. Mastercard Prepaid arranges for the issue of the Travel Platinum Card in conjunction with EML. Australian Postal Corporation (ABN 28 864 970 579, AR No. 338646), the card distributor, acts as an authorised representative of Australia Post Services Pty Ltd (ABN 67 002 599 340, AFSL 457551). You should consider the Travel Platinum Product Disclosure Statement, Financial Services Guide and Target Market Determination before deciding to acquire the product. Any advice does not take into account your personal needs, financial circumstances or objectives and you should consider if it is appropriate for you.
16. Should an Eligible Entrant's contact details change during this promotion, it is the Eligible Entrant's responsibility to immediately notify the Promoter. A request to modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to the Promoter.

If for any reason, the Promoter is unable to run this promotion as planned, including tampering, infection by computer virus, bugs, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter that corrupt or otherwise affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, The Promoter may acting reasonably disqualify any person who tampers with, or engages in improper conduct in connection with, the entry or registration process. The Promoter may also cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion where reasonably necessary due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control or to address misuse, fraud, or regulatory or legal requirements. Where practicable, reasonable prior notice will be provided, subject to any written directions given under applicable law.
